May Special Plate Collection: Pink Haven Coalition — The Pink Haven Coalition was formed in response to the increasingly hostile legislative environment in the United States that seeks to eradicate transgender people from public life. This coalition, which includes both the Unitarian Universalist Association (UUA) and the Unitarian Universalist Service Committee (UUSC), is working to create networks of safety and direct support for transgendered people and their families. In addition to provide a variety of resources and information, the coalition helps people to relocate and to access health care across state lines.
